FinancialAid/Campership

Thank you for your interest in Beth Tfiloh Day Camps. The Camp Committee looks forward to receiving your application.

Unlike other summer programs, Beth Tfiloh Camps does not receive support from any public funds or private foundations. Camp operates entirely on revenue derived from camp fees and relies solely on those fees to pay all camp expenses. For these reasons, Beth Tfiloh Camps is limited in the amount of financial assistance it can provide to camper families. Financial aid/campership is not available for Nursery Camp.

If you decide to apply for financial aid/campership, use the checklist of items below to ensure you have all required materials necessary for consideration. In order to process your application, please email all completed, required, documentation listed below, in its entirety, via email at office@btcamps.org BEFORE March 1, 2026.
The 2026 financial aid/campership application, completed.
A completed 2026 registration for each camper for whom you are requesting aid, meaning, your camper(s) must already be enrolled in BT Camp to be considered for financial aid/campership for summer 2026. A minimum of a \$250.00 deposit plus the \$125.00 mandatory health/safety/security fee must have been paid at the time of each registration. Per camp policy, all monies, except for any non-refundable deposits, are refundable prior to March 1, 2026.
A copy of a completed <u>2025</u> 1040 tax return as applicable from each member in the household.
A copy of any/all <u>2025</u> W2s as applicable from each member in the household.
A copy of any/all 2025 1099s as applicable from each member in the household.
Families must either pay in full for camp at the time of registration for each camper or make the required monthly payments, as per terms detailed on the application, while awaiting their financial aid/campership offer decision. If families pay in full, any financial assistance granted will be refunded to the credit card on file in CampMinder that was used to pay for the registration(s). For familie making monthly payments, the financial assistance will be deducted from your remaining balance. If financial assistance is awarded and you cancel any camp time, for any reason, you remain bound by the refund policy in effect at the time of cancellation and your assistance will be reduced accordingly. Decisions regarding financial aid/campership will be emailed after the Campership Review Committee convenes, usually by March 30 th .
If we are unable to give you the funds that you need, many area agencies and congregations have funds available for Jewish camp experiences and some rabbis will use their discretionary funds for this purpose should you choose to pursue that option. We do not accept vouchers as payment for any of our camp programs and/or associated fees.
