



BT CAMPS OPEN HOUSES!

Please join us for our new and improved Open Houses! These events are for new and young campers, but all families are more than welcome to join us to see the camp and meet the staff.

BIG CAMP - THURSDAY JUNE 16th (4:00 – 7:00pm) at BT Camps in Reisterstown.

*You may bring your own picnic dinner if you would like to spend some time at camp. Our pools will be open.

NURSERY CAMP - FRIDAY JUNE 17th (12:30 – 3:00pm) at Beth Tfiloh Nursery Camp in Pikesville.

If you cannot attend either of these events, you may call us to set up a tour of the facility on any day prior to June 22, 2021. Please call the camp office at 410-517-3451 to schedule.

BIG CAMP – DIRECTIONS and SPECIAL PARKING:

Because of the large number of parents and staff attending our Open House at the Big Camp, we ask you to follow special directions to an alternate parking area. This parking will still allow you quick access to our camp, however, the camp's main entrance will not be open to traffic.

Take the Northwest Expressway, I-795, toward Reisterstown. Use I-795 Exit 7B to Franklin Boulevard West. Stay on Franklin Boulevard to the second traffic signal where the road curves to the left and its name changes to Red Run Boulevard. Do not bear right as this will put you on Church Road. Stay on Red Run Boulevard for exactly one mile and turn right into **Redland Court**. Park in the lot at the end of the court. Pets are not allowed on camp property.

Note: During the camping season, there is no access to the camp either by car or on foot via Redland Court.

BIG CAMP - POINTS OF EMPHASIS:

You will be met by a Senior Camp Staff member who will guide you on a tour of camp. You will also be given a map upon arrival in case you are interested in walking around camp on your own, and we will have staff strategically placed throughout camp to help answer your questions.

You will see the whole camp, including all our activity areas. We will point out other important areas such as the Gatehouse, the Health Suite, the pools, the lake, bunk houses, athletic fields and much more. We will also have a school bus in our parking lot, and children who have never been on a school bus before will have the opportunity to get on the bus and get acclimated.

Additionally, you will be able to meet your child's counselors and Unit Head as you visit the bunkhouses, rooms, and activity areas. You will also be able to speak to members of the instructional staff, and meet Sam Bloom (Director), Evan Katz (Program Director)

NURSERY CAMP – POINTS OF EMPHASIS

You will be met by the Nursery Camp Director (Phaygi Chinn), and you will see the indoor classrooms and other facility locations, as well as see our outdoor space. You will meet your child's counselor, and we will discuss bunk sizes and our most updated Covid Safety Plans.
